Solar panels convert the light from the sun into electricity, with no moving parts they are very reliable a 30 year life is realistic, that means with payback averaged at 9 years, you can have 21 years of free electricity! Even on a bright Manx winters day a panel can generate a considerable amount of electricity (perhaps 30% of capacity).

In December 2020, the Isle of Man Government launched its Future Energy Scenarios Strategy to determine the pathways to meet the following: Electricity generation is responsible for approximately 33% of all greenhouse gas emissions on the Isle of Man, and a majority of this is currently sourced from fossil fuels (natural gas).

Proposals for the very first utility-scale solar farm on the Isle of Man have been released by designer Peel Cubico Renewables (PCR).
