What is muzzle energy for air guns?

This Muzzle Energy for Air Guns tool was built by Just Air Guns to help airgun enthusiasts calculate the FPS and FPE of their airguns. Below, we explain both FPS and FPE in detail. However, it is important that you understand that Muzzle Energy for Air Guns must stay within the legal limits set by law. WHAT IS FPS?

What is the airgun energy calculator?

This Airgun Energy Calculator is a simple widget designed to take the velocity of a projectile (bb, pellet, dart or bullet), its weight in grains, and calculate the foot pounds of energy (fpe) at the muzzle.

How should airguns be stored?

Airguns should be stored out of sight and separately from pellets. Airguns should be covered, for example in a gun case, when being transported. Airguns must not be stored where unauthorised people, particularly young people under the age of 18, might gain access to them. For example, use a lockable cupboard and keep the keys secure.

How do I find the FPE & fps of my airgun?

Use this free Muzzle Energy calculator to find out the FPE or FPS of your Airguns. Select (FPE) to find out the foot-pounds of energy of the exiting pellet. Select (FPS) to find out the feet per second velocity of the exiting pellet.

How do you calculate airgun fill time?

Find the foot-pounds of energy of the exiting pellet Find the velocity, feet per second, of the exiting pellet Calculated from retained velocity at two distances See how much velocity is retained at point of impact Determine how many fills you can get with your airgun Will Fill Gun Approximately Times! to standard 3000 psi 80 cu. ft. tank... Times!
