Do you need planning permission for a solar farm development?

6.55 Policy 1 of the LPP2, states that planning permission for new development will be granted provided that certain criteria, where relevant, are met. Criteria 1, 2, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 in particular are likely to be relevant to planning applications for major solar farm developments.

Do solar panels need planning permission?

It is true that the majority of solar PV installations will be classed as a PD. However, there are instances where you will need to seek planning permission from your local authority. This is the case if your solar panels: If you live in Scotland, there are a few additional rules that require planning permission.

Who decides on solar farm planning permission in Scotland?

In Scotland, the UK government is not remotely involved in deciding on solar farm planning permission. Instead, applications exceeding 50 MW will go straight to the Scottish Government Energy Consents Unit (ECU). Scottish Ministers will then answer individual developers about whether a project is feasible and will proceed.

Can you get planning permission for solar in the UK?

Over the years, obtaining planning permission for solar in the UK has become more complex. However, there's still reason to be optimistic. The government said it would update its National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) in late 2023.
