

Australia to add 376MWh of lithium battery energy storage by 2025

How many GW / 10 GWh of battery energy storage are there in Australia?

A record 4 GW/10 GWh of grid-scale battery energy storage projects commenced construction across Australia in 2023 but that mark is almost certain to be eclipsed this year.

How many energy storage projects are there in Australia?

This is the first time Australian storage projects have broken the billion-dollar barrier in a single quarter. These 6 energy storage projects will add 3,802 MWh to Australia's storage capacity. In Q2 2023, the report also showed: 4 storage projects reached the final commissioning stage. Some notable big battery projects in Australia include:

Is Australia the world's fourth-largest battery market?

Australia has firmed as the world's fourth-largest market for utility scale batteries with new data from research consultancy Rystad Energy revealing that almost 3 GW / 8 GWh of battery energy storage projects have started construction in the first seven months of 2024.

Which US companies are making lithium batteries in Australia?

Western Australia in particular saw lithium refining and processing plants come online last year and the Inflation Reduction Act in the US has prompted American companies - including US-Australian battery cell maker Recharge Industries and iron-flow battery maker ESS Inc - to announce Australian manufacturing plans.

What batteries are being built in Australia?

AGL: a new 250 MW / 500 MWh battery in Liddell, NSW. FRV: a new 250 MW / 550 MWh battery in Gnarwarre, VIC. Neoen: retrofitting the 300 MW / 450 MWh Victorian Big Battery in Moorabool, VIC to enable grid-forming capability. Neoen: a new 200 MW / 400 MWh battery in the Western Downs, QLD. How much money did Australia invest in energy storage in Q2 2023?

Investment in large-scale energy storage projects in Australia reached a record high in the second quarter of 2023. The Clean Energy Council's Renewable Projects Quarterly Report (PDF, 1.92 MB) showed 6 energy storage and hybrid projects worth A\$2 billion reached investment stage in Q2 2023.

That investment includes supporting Synergy to expand its portfolio of battery energy storage assets to 3 GWh of storage capacity by the end of 2025. Installation of the Kwinana batteries comes as Synergy gears up to begin works early this year in Collie on one of Australia's biggest lithium-based batteries.

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The EIA expects a further increase in battery storage installations, partly due to falling battery storage costs. 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Sodium-ion is one technology to watch. To be sure, sodium-ion batteries are still behind lithium-ion batteries in some important respects. Sodium-ion batteries have lower cycle life (2,000-4,000 versus 4,000-8,000 for lithium) and lower energy density (120-160 watt-hours per kilogram versus 170-190 watt-hours per kilogram for LFP).

Five energy infrastructure projects representing 750 MW of renewable energy generation and 524 MW/4,192 MWh of long-duration storage have been successful to the New South Wales government's latest tender round as it prepares for the exit of coal-fired power generation from the state's electricity grid.

The Moss Landing Energy Storage Facility, located just south of San Francisco, California, has been connected to the power grid and began storing energy on Dec. 11, 2020. At 300 MW/1,200 MWh, this lithium-ion battery-based energy storage system is likely the largest in the world. The system is located on-site at Vistra's Moss Landing Power Plant.



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
