What is a roof mounted photovoltaic system guidance?

The guidance refers only to the mechanical installation of roof mounted integrated and stand-off photovoltaic systems; it provides best practice guidance on installation requirements and does not constitute fixing instructions.

What are the different types of PV installation?

There are two main types of PV installation: integrated into the roof surface, often referred to as Building-Integrated Photovoltaic (BIPV) systems or mounted above the existing roof covering, also referred to as stand-off systems.

Can a PV system be electrically installed?

Guidance exists for electrical installation of PV systems [15,16,17] but there is little equivalent guidance for mechanical installation.

Where should a solar photovoltaic installation be installed?

The installation looks best when the panels run parallel to the edge that is nearest them, which is usually the eaves. We recognise that after performance, aesthetics are the most important aspect of a solar photovoltaic installation and so our installation teams will ensure this to be the case.

Can a PV system be installed on a flat roof?

Figure 24 shows a typical PV installation on a flat roof. The only sources of rain leakage with these systems are where there are penetrations through the roof waterproofing layer. It is always good practice to avoid such penetrations because they are generally hard to seal and inspection is often difficult.

How should a PV system be designed & installed?

From the outset, the designer and installer of a PV system must consider the potential hazards carefully, and systematically devise methods to minimise the risks. This will include both mitigating potential hazards present during and after the installation phase.

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A solar panel wiring diagram (also known as a solar panel schematic) is a technical sketch detailing what equipment you need for a solar system as well as how everything should connect together.
