

# Birds passing by a solar power tower

Can birds be killed if they smash into solar panels?

Birds can be killed when they smash into the facility's solar panels, the investigation concluded. The other solar farms analyzed by the investigators were of the newfangled trough and solar power tower varieties.

Can birds be burned by solar power?

The third facility studied was the Ivanpah Solar Electric Generating System in Bernardino County, Calif., where birds can be burned as they pass through concentrated sunrays that are reflected off thousands of mirrors toward a solar power tower, where water is boiled to produce electricity-generating steam.

How do power towers work?

Power Towers use mirrors to concentrate solar rays onto a receiver to turn the solar energy into heat. The problem with concentrating so much solar energy into one place is that birds are attracted to the light beam and the mirrors, and the intense heat kills more birds than would be saved from avoided emissions.

Do solar panels attract water birds?

Ghazi and Ip (2014) refers to birds being attracted to the warmth of solar panels in summer months for which a citation is provided, however the original paper could not be found for this review. Toral and Figuerola (2010) state that the installation of solar farms on land used for rice cultivation would be detrimental to some water bird species.

Are migratory birds a problem with solar power?

The recognition of a potential conflict between solar electricity generation and birds is historical, Maag Jr. (1977) makes reference to "unwelcome migratory birds" as an environmental variable that may affect PV performance- perhaps reflecting a shift in attitude towards the conservation of biodiversity too.

Do solar farms affect birds?

A brochure for the BTO's farmland bird appeal highlights the need for research into strategies for minimising negative impacts and maximising positive impacts of solar farms on birds (BTO, n.d.). This document suggests that bird surveys should be undertaken (taxa non-specific) at solar farms to determine how birds might be affected.

Two distinct CSP technologies have gained dominance in solar power production: solar "power towers", which use flat mirrors called heliostats to reflect solar radiation to a central focal point on a tower, and "troughs", which use parabolic mirrors to reflect solar radiation to a receiver tube (Hernandez et al. 2014) (Figure 1).

In 2018, worldwide and operational solar power tower gross installed capacity was 618.42 MW and, in the following years, it will finish achieving 995 MW [27]. The overall capacity of under construction and development solar power towers reached around 5383 MWh e in 2019, with an average power capacity of 207 MWh e [5].
