

Can cat food get damp when stored in a locker

How do you store cat food?

To store wet food properly, keep opened food refrigerated, store unopened food in a cool, dry place, and avoid common storage mistakes to ensure your cat is receiving a healthy meal. Put the unused food in an airtight container. If you did not use all of the food in the packaging, put it into an airtight container immediately after opening it.

Can you put dry cat food in another storage container?

If you need to pour dry cat food into another storage container because the original package has become torn or damaged, make sure the container is clean and perfectly dry, and has an airtight lid, says Dr. Gary Weitzman, CEO of the San Diego Humane Society.

Can cat food be refrigerated?

Opened wet food will dry out in several hours. Therefore, any wet food left in your cat's bowl for more than an hour should be picked up and tossed out. Any food left in the can should be covered and refrigerated right away. Be sure to seal the can (a plastic can lid works great for this) before refrigerating.

Can you store cat food in a ziploc bag?

Ziploc bags are good moisture barriers but do not provide good oxygen and odor barriers." Extreme temperatures (too hot or too cold) and high humidity can cause cat food to degrade or spoil. Store cat food in the house in a cool, dry, dark place like your pantry. Do not store cat food on the porch, in the garage or in the trunk of your car.

Can wet cat food be stored the same way as dry cat food? No, the two types of food are stored in completely different ways. Both wet and dry food can be kept at room temperature before opening, for example, in a cupboard. After opening, canned cat food can be stored in the refrigerator for 5-7 days.

For the past 4 or so years, we have been feeding her the following: 1/4 3 oz. can of Fancy Feast grain-free wet classic pate (in a variation of flavors) 3x a day (9a, 4:30p, and 10p) + she has 24/7 access to dry food (Rachael Ray Nutrish Indoor Complete Natural Dry Cat Food in a couple different flavors) which is stored in a food dispenser.
