

# Concealed installation of photovoltaic panels

What type of fixing system is used for solar PV panels?

The type of fixing system used will depend on whether the solar PV panels are going to be: ground mounted. Solar PV panels can be retrofitted onto an existing roof, on top of the tiles or other roofing materials, using roof anchors (also called roof-hooks or brackets), mounting rails and clamps.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.

How do I isolate my PV system from the AC installation?

In all cases it is essential to ensure that the PV system is securely isolated from the AC installation. At least simple separation is required between DC and the AC sides of the PV supply system to prevent DC fault currents from being fed to the AC side.

Your installer must gain building regulations approval from your local authority for their solar panel system plan before they can proceed. They will have to prove your roof can comfortably support the weight of your chosen ...
