Introduction: Overview of the EU-China solar panel dispute
In 2012, the European Commission launched an anti-dumping and anti-subsidy investigation on solar panels imported from China after a petition from Belgium.

What role did the Commissioner play in the EU-China solar panel dispute?

The Commissioner had an essential role in the issue identification and decision-making stages. Why did the escalation of solar panel antidumping lead to a trade war?

In the lead up to the Paris Conference the sharp reduction in the price of solar panels installed in Europe induced by the Chinese imports was seen by many as positive for EU's climate policy goals. Thus, the escalation of the solar panel antidumping case brought the EU and China to the brink of a trade war.

Why did EU Prosun complain about Chinese solar panels?

On July 25, 2012, EU ProSun, an industry association representing over 20 European solar companies, lodged a formal complaint that solar panels and their key components imported from China were entering the European market at prices below market value.

Can the EU dumping solar panels on the EU market?

Like the EU industry needed to lodge a complaint on the dumping of solar panels on the EU market, the Commission could not act in this case (Interview senior EU officials, July 22, 2015). A group of Chinese exporting solar panel producers gave a mandate to the CCCME to submit a price undertaking.
