Do I need DNO permission for a solar PV system?

You need DNO permission for any solar PV system or EV Charger that connects to the National Grid, unless it is an off-grid system. This is because you have to follow the National Grid rules in your region when you connect to it.

Do I need a DNO certificate to install a solar PV system?

You need a DNO certificate to install a solar panel system that connects to the National Grid. Otherwise, you will miss out on the Smart Export Guarantee (SEG) scheme payments from the National Grid, which is a reward for being connected to the National Grid. The type of DNO application you need depends on the size of your solar PV system.

What if I don't have a solar monitoring system?

Users who do not have a solar monitoring system should try monitoring their solar panels by keeping an eye on their solar inverters. If they do not have solar monitoring through a company, they likely have a string inverter that came with their solar panels. A string inverter is larger than the micro-inverters attached to individual solar panels.

How much does a solar PV monitoring device cost?

Monitoring devices can be fitted to the solar PV system to measure the power output. They are available from suppliers like Amazon and may cost between £75 and £100 depending on the model chosen. Some can be fitted with guidance from an installation manual, but others may require an electrician to fit them.
