What are master keyed locks?

Master keyed locks are a great example of this. A master key system will make your locks vulnerable to several types of attacks: Exploratory keys are used to decode master keyed systems with only your change key and the lock it opens.

What is a Master Key System?

These are a number of locks where one 'master' key can open all the locks in a suite, each lock within a master key suite also has its own set of keys. A basic master key system comprises of a Master Key which passes a group of locks, each with its own separate 'differ' key.

Can I get a master key if my lock is not mastered?

Master keys are only available for locks that have been 'mastered'. You cannot have a master key for a lock that is non-mastered. Master keys are difficult to replicate, meaning that a high-street key replacement service may not be able to replicate the key to a working level.

How does a Master Key System maintain security?

The master key system maintains security by allowing each change key to open only a specific lock, while the master key, through a unique arrangement of pins and spacers, can access all locks within the group without compromising individual lock security. What limitations exist with the master key system in terms of security?

Does Lowe & Fletcher have a master key?

Many of Lowe & Fletcher's locks come with a master key if required, most commonly for caretakers or building owners who require a master key door lock system in case of misplaced or stolen keys. A master key allows the keeper to open a number of locks from one key, despite each lock having its own individual key.

What is the difference between mastered and non-mastered locks?

Locks that are mastered are manufactured to open using the key as supplied and a master key. So if any of the keys are misplaced, the master key can be used to open any of the locks in that particular set or suite. Locks that are non-mastered can only be opened by the key supplied with the lock.

A key will generally only have one indented side, however symmetrical keys are available (where both sides of the key are indented), meaning it can be used any way round; not to be confused with dimple keys. The dimple key can have biting and warding located on one or both sides of the key to suit the number of master pins within the lock barrel.
