Could Zambia's energy crisis worsen its economy?

Experts say the severe energy crisis could worsen Zambia's already fragile economy and lead to massive job losses.

Why are Zambia's power cuts so bad?

The power cuts have come as a shock to the 43% of Zambians who are connected to the grid and have taken electricity for granted all their lives. But one of the severest droughts in decades - caused by the El Niño weather phenomenon - has decimated Zambia's power-generation capacity.

What caused Zambia's worst electricity blackouts?

Zambia's worst electricity blackouts in memory have been caused by a severe drought in the region that has left the critical Kariba dam, the source of Musonda's woes, with insufficient water to run its hydroelectric turbines. How much electricity does Zambia have?

Zambia relies on Kariba for more than 80% of its national electricity supply, and the result is Zambians have barely a few hours of power a day at the best of times. Will Zambia have 3 hours of electricity a day?

On Wednesday, there was finally some good news when Minister of Energy Makozo Chikote said the plant was now fully operational, and Zambians would have at least three hours of electricity a day.

Does Zambia have hydroelectric power?

Zambia is not alone in that hydroelectric power makes up over 80% of the energy mix in Mozambique, Malawi, Uganda, Ethiopia and Congo, even as experts warn it will become more unreliable.
