Why does Fiji need a new energy strategy?

Since, Fiji is completely dependent on imported fossil fuels for its transportation needs and 33% dependent on electricity generation, it has to import despite increasing costs. In addition, it cannot control the global prices. To overcome challenges in energy sector, Fiji needs to come up with strategies.

What is Fiji's national energy policy 2023-2030?

Fiji's National Energy Policy 2023-2030 is the blueprint towards a highly sustainable, inclusive, reliable, and affordable energy services sector by the close of the decade. It sets a strong policy foundation for the transformational investments that are urgently needed to revolutionise our energy sector for the better.

Does Fiji have a good energy supply?

Like for many other SIDS Fiji's geographical situation means that affordable and accessible energy supply is a challenge. The Island state depends heavily on imported fossil fuel to meet its energy needs, nevertheless, renewable energy sources, mainly hydro, account for 55% of the country's total energy production.

What is the energy situation in Fiji?

It is a small island developing state (SIDS) that is heavily dependent on imported fossil fuel for its energy needs. In 2014, Fiji generated 859 GW h of grid electricity from 259.8 MW of power plants.
