Georgia also continues its leadership in solar energy development and is conducting some of the largest renewable solicitations in the country. Georgia Power currently provides energy to customers from approximately 2,700 MW* of solar and anticipates continuing to add significant amounts of solar to benefit customers in the coming years.

Georgia Power's 2023 tax payments to city, county, state and federal agencies totaled \$1.2 million, or about 13 percent of operating revenues. This represents approximately \$454 per customer. Georgia Power is one of Georgia's largest taxpayers.

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24/7 - more than twice as much as solar and wind resources. Nuclear power units also require fewer maintenance outages than coal or natural gas, making electricity even more reliable for Georgians.

The Proxy PPA is only offered to a Generator when Georgia Power has an identified capacity need in its most-recent IRP and has issued a capacity RFP pursuant to GPSC Rule 515-3-4.04(3)(b). A Generator eligible for the Proxy PPA has a QF with operating characteristics equivalent to a baseload resource and designed to meet a 96% availability requirement.

That puts Georgia Power on track to own and operate a total of 915 MW of BESS for Georgia over the next several years. Fitzgerald said she could see Georgia being in the top 5 states with battery capacity. "With the data center growth and adding more and more solar, we need to put in more batteries," she said.
