Can Ghana decarbonise the energy sector?

By Edward Acquah Accra, May 27, GNA- As the world races to transition from fossil fuel to renewable energy, Ghana has developed a National Energy Transition Framework (2022-2070) to decarbonise the energy sector to help achieve net zero targets as part of commitments under the Paris Agreement.

How much energy is needed in Ghana?

Around \$70 billion of cumulative energy supply investment is needed in the STEPS, 60% of which is for upstream oil and gas. Investment ramps up by nearly 45% in the AC, with a strong emphasis on renewables and electricity networks. Thanks to notable efforts on electrification, the goal of full access is within grasp in Ghana.

Will natural gas be part of Ghana's energy mix in 2022?

Speaking at the 2022 Ghana International Petroleum Conference (GhIPCon) in Accra in September 2022, Vice President Dr Mahumudu Bawumia said natural gas would continue to be part of Ghana's energy mix in the short term as the country takes steps to fully transition from fossil fuels to renewable energy by 2070.

What is Ghana's Energy Transition Plan?

Solar and biomass contributed one per cent each to the energy mix. Currently, about 70 per cent of Ghana's generation installed capacity of 5,321 MW is from a thermal plant that uses natural gas as its primary fuel. Scope of framework Ghana's energy transition plan identifies energy and transportation sectors as key areas in reducing emissions.

The Government has committed to building an energy sector based on long-term energy security, sustainable investment, and partnerships to bring affordable accessible energy to the people of Ghana, in line with the vision of a Ghana Beyond Aid. To achieve this vision, Government has taken pragmatic and decisive action to manage the energy sector.

Ghana's debt crisis makes it hard for the government to pay power suppliers when state-owned energy distributor Electricity Company of Ghana Ltd. can't foot its monthly bills, said Kodzo Yaotse at the Africa Centre for Energy Policy. "When power is given to ECG for sale, they're only able to recover 45%," Yaotse said.
