

Grenada solar energy in europe

How much electricity does Grenada use?

In 2020,Grenada produced 223 GWhof electricity,relying mainly on fossil fuels (98.12%),with a small contribution from solar energy (1.88%). In 2018,peak demand was 33.2 MW. In 2016,Grenada consumed 185.1 million kWh of electricity. As of 2018,95.3% of the population had access to electricity.

How has Grenada restructured its energy sector?

Grenada confirms its previous commitment of reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 40% of the 2010 levels by 2030. Grenada will continue to comprehensively address disaster risk reduction, and loss and damage. Grenada restructured its electricity sector to facilitate renewable energy deployment.

Does Grenada have solar power?

Solar photovoltaics (PV) have high potential on Grenada because the country's global horizontal irradiation exceeds 5 kWh/square meters per day. A 2- to 4-MW PV installation is planned,but no utility-scale solar plants are currently in operation.

Where does Grenada get its energy from?

Grenada derives almost all of its energy from imported hydrocarbons. In 2020,non-renewables accounted for roughly 98% of installed capacity and electricity generation,with solar energy making up the difference.

Did investors share Grenada's vision of restructuring the electricity sector?

Investors did notshare Grenada's vision of restructuring the electricity sector and making significant investments in renewable energy,as evidenced in an investment arbitration case,Grenada Private Power Limited and WRB Enterprises,Inc. v. Grenada (ICSID Case No. ARB/17/13).

How much does solar cost in Grenada?

According to data from 2014,the costs of utility-scale solar in Grenada are estimated to be between \$0.21/kWh and \$0.44/kWh; wind costs are estimated to be between \$0.05/kWh and \$0.20/kWh.
