What is a solar tube?

The solar tube is also known as the sun tube, light tube, sun tunnel, tubular skylight and daylight pipe. It looks exactly like a tube, thus its name. The solar tube mentioned here is not to be confused with thin-film agricultural solar tubes and photovoltaic solar tubes which are mainly made for generating electricity.

What is a photovoltaic-integrated solar tube?

The photovoltaic-integrated solar tubes are the newest type. It is a hybrid with different additional features: Photovoltaic or solar cells are integrated into this type of solar tube, allowing you to generate electricity while sunlight streams through the tube. Some models come with an in-tube bulb which you can dim as and when you wish.

Should you choose a solar tube or a skylight?

If you need light at night, too, choose a solar tube model that includes an electric light. Given their size, skylights are hard to miss when you walk into a room. Solar tubes, on the other hand, are subtle design elements that add light without calling attention to themselves.

Under-sizing Your Inverter. Definitely run a ground wire so you can bond PV panel frames to chassis of inverter or charge controller. That protects against DC shock in case of a short at the array (including cracked panel and water). It also protects against AC shock; many AIO inverters couple AC onto PV wires, and there is capacitance to frame.

Inner tubes are called twin-glass tubes or thermos-flask tubes and are covered with a special coating that absorbs solar energy but limits heat loss. Inner tubes are made of borosilicate or soda lime glass due to its strength and resistance to high temperatures, and has a high transmittance for solar irradiation.

Under typical UK conditions, 1m² of PV panel will produce around 100kWh electricity per year, so it would take around 2.5 years to "pay back" the energy cost of the panel. PV panels have an expected life of least 25 to 30 years, so even under UK conditions a PV panel will generate many times more energy than was needed to manufacture it.



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
