What is a solar panel payback period?

A solar panel payback period is the length of time it takes for the savings on electricity bills to equal the initial investment made in a solar energy system. How long do solar panels last in the UK?

Domestic solar panel systems in the UK typically have payback periods ranging from 5 to 7 years, though, as we've already covered, this can be shorter or longer depending on multiple factors. Commercial solar installations can see payback periods as short as 1 to 3 years, sometimes even less for larger systems.

What is a solar panel rent-a-roof scheme?

The Rent-a-Roof scheme lets people who can't otherwise afford solar panels gain access to them, through installers who will setup solar panels on roofs for reduced prices. Installers can then sell any excess electricity generated back to the grid.

Are solar panels paying rent for your roof?

Technically, they're not paying rent for your roof, because you'll get the benefit of powering your home using solar power instead of grid electricity. They'll make money from the electricity you don't use. All excess electricity generated is sold back to the grid via the Smart Export Guarantee (SEG) scheme.

Can you get free solar panels on a roof?

Companies offered to pay to lease your roof from you for 20-25 years and, in exchange, would install and maintain solar PV panels on it. You didn't have to pay upfront for the panels, and would also benefit from the free electricity produced by the system. But there are very few free solar panel schemes available now.
