What is the school system in so Tome & Principe?

The school system used in São Tomé and Principe before independence was basically the same as in Portugal (as it was one of its colonies). Nowadays, schooling is compulsory for four years only, which belongs to primary education. After graduation from primary school, Sao Tomeans can then proceed to secondary school.

What is compulsory education in Sao Tome and Principe?

The compulsory education, as mentioned earlier, is for the primary level only. All children that reach the age of six have to be enrolled to any of Sao Tome and Principe's primary school. For six years, parents can save on education expenditures as it is free. After graduation from primary school, Sao Tomeans can then proceed to secondary school.

How many pupils are enrolled in primary education in Sao Tome & Principe?

UNESCO definitions are used for all tables and figures, unless otherwise stated. Sao Tome and Principe has a total of 63,000 pupils enrolled in primary and secondary education. Of these pupils, about 37,000 (59%) are enrolled in primary education.

Where does Sao Tome and Principe rank in access to education?

Figure 8 demonstrates where Sao Tome and Principe stands in comparison to other low and middle income countries in access to education, measured as the primary school net enrollment rate, and youth literacy. Compared to other countries, Sao Tome and Principe ranks at the 75 percentile in access and at the 51 percentile in learning.

Do children go to school in Sao Tome & Principe?

By law, children are required to complete elementary school, but many do not; a rare few progress to high school. Sao Tome and Principe had 13 preprimary schools with 3,446 students in 1989; 69 primary schools (grades 1-4) with 20,502 students in 1997, and 10 secondary schools (5-9) with 12,280 children.

What is the enrollment rate in Sao Tome & Principe?

In Sao Tome and Principe, the gross enrollment rate in primary education is 110% for both girls and boys combined. This decreases to 107% in lower secondary, with a student transition rate to secondary school of 97%. In Sao Tome and Principe, the primary net enrollment rate is 96% and the primary completion rate is 87%.
