Meanwhile, a 5kW solar panel requires a bigger budget and should cost about ₹7,500 to ₹9,000, but as mentioned earlier, it carries a much larger load. Naturally, these factors also affect the price with the typical 3kW monocrystalline coming to between ₹5,000 to ₹6,000 .
