Post bases, typically made from metal, attach directly to the surface of the concrete. You drill into the concrete and insert concrete screws or anchors. Some brackets clamp to the concrete beams and others are built into the floor structure. Support brackets should be suitable for an underfloor environment. Lightly pre-galvanised thin strapping can easily rust and collapse, so it should not be used. Purpose-made stainless steel or suitably galvanised brackets are more appropriate.
