



How to guarantee the service life of solar photovoltaic panels

Do solar panels come with a warranty?

Solar panels usually come with two types of warranties: The product warranty covers defects in the solar panel itself and typically covers around 20-25 years, although some manufacturers offer longer warranties up to 30 years or beyond.

How long do solar panels last?

Workmanship and materials warranty of one or two years. Batteries (non-grid systems / hybrids) roughly 5-15 years. Inverter (s) warranty of between 5-10 years. There are many factors that must be borne in mind when considering warranties for your solar panel system.

What is a solar performance warranty?

The performance warranty guarantees that the solar panels will produce a certain percentage of their rated power output over time, usually promising around 80-90% of their original output by the end of the warranty period. These warranties protect your solar investment by making sure the panels work as they should for a long time.

Do solar panels need to be changed over 25 years?

The one component that will probably need changing over the 25-year lifespan of the panels is the inverter (which converts the DC output of a photovoltaic panel into the AC required by local and commercial power grids), which costs an average of \$1000. Solar panels are exposed to dirt, debris and pollution.

How long does a solar panel's power warranty last?

Most solar panel power warranties nowadays offer linear degradation, meaning a 0.7% output loss per year. However, some manufacturers like SunPower offer a much higher output guarantee after 25 years. In the past, power warranties were stepped, guaranteeing 90% output after 10 years and 80% output after 25 years.

How long does a solar inverter last?

A good quality inverter can last upwards of 15 years whereas a poor quality one will only last 5, with top manufacturers claiming over 20 years usable lifespan! Solar panels can also require more regular maintenance in order to get rid of dirt and debris. Other complications can pop up too, with little warning. Solar panel owners told a Which? survey in 2022 that they'd seen their panels get cracked or broken, suddenly produce less or no electricity, and experience electrical problems.

As an example of how you use warranty information to figure out how long a solar panel lasts, consider a typical residential PV panel rated at 300 watts (W). According to a standard solar panel performance warranty,

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a 300W solar panel is guaranteed to produce at least $300\text{W} \times 0.80 = 240\text{W}$ at 25 years post-installation. (80% = 0.8.)

First, it is significant to bear in mind that diverse opinions are generated about the useful life of solar PV panels. Generally, producers suggest that the useful life of a solar panel is approximately 25 to 30 years.
