

How to install photovoltaic panels on the middle floor

How do I install a solar panel?

Installing your solar panel is a straightforward process though calling in professional installers is recommended. Making sure these installers are accredited by MCS is highly important, so as to ensure a high standard of installation. Is my home suitable for solar PV panels? A solar panel will be most effective if you have a south-facing roof.

Where should a solar photovoltaic installation be installed?

The installation looks best when the panels run parallel to the edge that is nearest them, which is usually the eaves. We recognise that after performance, aesthetics are the most important aspect of a solar photovoltaic installation and so our installation teams will ensure this to be the case.

Can solar panels be installed vertically or horizontally?

The panels themselves can be installed vertically or horizontally. Once the mounting system is set up, it's time for the moment we've all been waiting for: getting the solar panels onto the roof. Your installer will start by placing the solar panels onto the mounting system, without fully securing them just yet.

Can a solar panel be installed on a south-facing roof?

A solar panel will be most effective if you have a south-facing roof. This will ensure maximum sunlight reaches the panel. You will also have to make sure that your roof can support a panel, and that it has a large enough area for panel installation. Do I need planning permission for solar panels?

Can solar panels be mounted on a flat roof?

For solar panels on a flat roof, mounting systems are slightly different and can include a triangle 'ballast' box to support the panels. For solar thermal panels (with cells that use the sun's heat to warm water in a house) things are a little different.

What angle should solar panels be installed on a roof?

Anywhere between 20 and 50 degrees will usually enable your system to produce roughly as much electricity as it could. And in the case of most rooftop solar panel installations, the angle of the solar panels is determined by the angle of the roof - so there isn't much you can do to change it.
