Where should a solar photovoltaic installation be installed?

The installation looks best when the panels run parallel to the edge that is nearest them, which is usually the eaves. We recognise that after performance, aesthetics are the most important aspect of a solar photovoltaic installation and so our installation teams will ensure this to be the case.

How to wire solar panels in parallel?

Wiring solar panels in parallel implies connecting positive terminals of each panel together and wiring the negative terminals of each panel together as well. Then, they are connected to the charge controller or to the inverter of the solar system.

How do you install solar panels on a roof?

This is done by lifting some roof tiles in order to fix anchor points to the rafters. To these roof anchor points are attached the solar panel mounting system. The mounting system supports the foundation of your solar panels, keeping them in place at the optimal angle to receive sunlight.

Install the inverter on the support wall. Connect it to the fuse box and charge the controller to complete the electrical setup. Step 2: Work on the solar panel connections.
