How long do solar panels last on a flat roof?

Most UK roofs are strong enough to hold solar panels for their entire lifespan - which can last 40 years or more. This is because a solar panel system usually weighs about 20kg per square metre, which the great majority of roofs can hold. However, flat roofs may not always be strong enough for solar panels.

Should I replace my flat roof before installing solar panels?

The majority of flat roofs are made of traditional felt, which has a lifespan of approximately 15 years. So if your flat roof is over 10 years old, it would definitely be worth replacing it before installing solar panels. The same applies if you are planning to build an extension on your home and place solar panels on the flat roof.

Do solar panels need to be installed on a roof?

The bottom edge of the solar panel should be flush with the bottom edge bar. With the panel in position check to see if the fixing holes at the top fall on tiling batten. If not install an additional batten the width of the system in order to fix the panels to. Using the self-tapping screws, fix the panel securely using both fixing holes.

How to Install Solar Panels. Installing solar panels starts with safety and preparation. Follow these solar panel mounting instructions for a successful diy solar panel setup. Setting Up Scaffolding. Starting any installation means safety first. Begin by setting up scaffolding around the area. This makes a stable platform and cuts fall risks.

Ideally, install the inverter on an exterior wall between your solar panel's junction box and the main circuit breaker panel to your house. Some code's will require the inverter and your AC Disconnect switch to be within a certain distance of your electricity meter.
