Installing solar panels on a rooftop is generally straightforward, though it's not without its challenges. In most cases, solar panels can be installed on almost any type of roof. However, given the diversity of roof types and materials found in Spain, each installation needs to be assessed individually.

Solar panels should be installed below the highest point of the roof. The solar panels should be installed no greater than 20cm above the surface of the roof, or away from the surface of the wall that they are installed on. Why aren't solar-powered cars practical? A typical home needs a solar array covering 500 square feet to produce as much power as the people inside need in a year.
