

Is solar energy an essential part of the UAE's energy mix?

In addition to these drivers, a good exposure to the sun justifies why solar energy has dominated those activities. The aim of this research is to review and build on the existing knowledge to assess whether solar energy can be an essential part of the UAE's energy mix.

Does the United Arab Emirates have solar power?

While being a major oil producing country, the United Arab Emirates (UAE) has taken steps to introduce solar power on a large scale. However, solar power still accounts for a small share of energy production in the country.

What is the solar energy resource in the UAE?

Solar energy resource The UAE lies between 22°30' and 26°10' north latitude and between 51°0' and 56°25' east longitude which gives an indication of its good solar energy exposure. However, high concentrations of airborne dust particles and high humidity tend to diffuse and attenuate the intensity of solar irradiance.

How many solar panels does the UAE use?

It uses almost 4 million solar panels which deploy innovative bi-facial technology, ensuring sunlight is captured on both sides of the panels to maximize yield. In less than fifteen years, the UAE has become a global leader in solar energy.

How much does solar energy cost in Abu Dhabi?

Mezher et al. argues that the cost of electricity and water are heavily subsidized, and this makes electricity from solar energy in a disadvantage cost-wise. It is mentioned that the cost from the 10 MW plant for instance is around 48 cents per kWh while the residents of Abu Dhabi pay around 25 cents.

Dubai Electricity & Water Authority (DEWA) is executing the world's largest single-site solar park, the Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum Solar Park. In 2012, the UAE initiated the construction of the Barakah Nuclear Energy Plant in Abu Dhabi to supply approximately 25% of the UAE's electricity needs and reduce the country's carbon footprint.

The Noor Abu Dhabi solar park will reduce the UAE's carbon footprint by 1 million metric tons per year, which is equivalent to taking 200,000 cars off the road.
