Monocrystalline solar panels are made from a single silicon crystal and tend to be more expensive but convert 15-24% of sunlight. Some common solar panel system sizes include a 3kW solar panel system, a 4 kilowatt solar panel system and a 5kW solar panels. For instance, a typical 2kW solar panel system suited for 1-3 people will need anywhere between 5 and 8 solar panels (for 350W panels).
