

Why is Saudi Arabia investing in solar energy?

Which solar energy projects are completed in Saudi Arabia by 2030?

The Lunch of Saudi Solar Energy Program Sakaka, Al Shuaibah, and Sudair Solar Energy Projects have been completed. By 2030, the goal is 40GW PV solar and 2.7GW (CSP) concentrated solar power capacity.

Can solar energy be used in Saudi Arabia?

The average energy from the sunlight falling on Saudi Arabia is 2200 thermal kWh/m² (Alawaji, 2001), and it is therefore worthwhile to attempt to generate clean energy in the country via direct sunlight through PV cells. Applications of solar energy in Saudi Arabia have been growing since 1960.

How much solar power will Saudi Arabia have by 2032?

The Saudi agency in charge of developing the nation's renewable energy sector, KA-CARE, announced in May 2012 that the nation would install 41 gigawatts (GW) of solar capacity by 2032. It was projected to be composed of 25 GW of solar thermal, and 16 GW of photovoltaics.

Saudi Arabia is a member of the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries, with an annual GDP of \$1,108,150 million [10] and also a country heavily relying on fossil fuels that results in large-scale CO₂ emission [7], [11]. According to Patalong [12], Saudi Arabia has set ambitious goals for renewable energy, hoping to reach 27.3 GW by 2024 and 58.7 GW by 2030.
