The best angle for a solar panel system in the UK is between 20° and 50°. At this kind of angle, your solar panels will be exposed to more sunlight, which will lead to more energy production and larger savings.

However, if you aren't lucky enough to have a suitable south facing roof, installation on roof faces just off south, or even east or west, can still provide a large amount of generation to offset the homeowner's annual electricity usage. The only orientation which isn't suitable or recommended to install on is a north facing roof.

The angle or tilt of a solar panel is also an important factor. The angle that a solar panel should be set at to produce the most energy in a given year is determined by the geographical latitude. A general rule for optimal annual energy production is to set the solar panel tilt angle equal to the geographical latitude.

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
