

Rwanda electric power grid

Does Rwanda have a power grid?

Rwanda is planning to expand from 276 MW of grid power in 2022 to 556 MW in 2024 and may import some additional electricity from neighboring countries. In addition, it is installing small solar units throughout the country to ensure that households located in off-grid areas have access to electricity, or to help deal with power outages.

How much electricity does Rwanda use?

The extent of grid electricity is limited and mainly concentrated near Kigali. Most of the country uses firewood as its main energy source. Rwanda is planning to expand from 276 MW of grid power in 2022 to 556 MW in 2024 and may import some additional electricity from neighboring countries.

Will Rwanda expand its grid power in 2024?

Rwanda is planning to expand its grid power up to 556 MW in 2024. How has off-grid technology boosted Rwanda's capacity to avail electricity to more people?

The innovation of off-grid technologies has greatly boosted Rwanda's capacity to avail electricity to more people. Rwandan households have access to electricity. of the available electric energy is imported while the rest is domestically generated.

What percentage of electricity is generated by hydropower in Rwanda?

53% of electricity is generated by hydropower. At the end of 2018, Rwanda's grid-connected power plants supplied 221.1 MW. KivuWatt project is an energy project to extract natural gas dissolved in Lake Kivu and use the extracted gas to generate electricity.

How many people can a power plant provide in Rwanda?

In 2016, the operational 25 MW power plant was able to provide enough energy for 45,000 people in Rwanda. The ongoing expansion project is expected to add 26 MW of generating capacity in its first phase, and eventually scale up to 100 MW in the coming years.

Currently, the total installed capacity to generate electricity in Rwanda is 332.6 MW from different power plants. By generation technology mix, 51% is from thermal sources, followed by hydro sources (43.9%) and solar sources with 4.2%.

The 70kV lines previously running through Birembo-Musha to Kabarondo substation that existed till 2013, were upgraded to 110 kV to improve network reliability and power supply stability amidst the country's changing power demand profile.

national grid capacity. Rwanda's electricity production has grown from 5 percent in 2005 to 21 percent. The government says it intends to produce 70 percent by 2017.

Rwanda's Electricity Grid System is divided into High Voltage - HV (110kV and 220kV) Medium Voltage MV (15kV and 30kV) and Low Voltage-LV (0.4kV) Rwanda is being interconnected to the region through the 220kV backbone; plans are underway to introduce a 400kV once the regional power trading has been effected.

Rwanda has one of the smallest energy sectors among sub-Saharan African countries - but one with a lot of activity and innovation. The government is pressing towards two ambitious targets by June 2018: to increase total power capacity to 563MW and access to electricity to 70%, while reducing carbon intensity of the power mix by 10%.
