Why is Saudi Arabia moving towards solar energy?

This move towards solar energy in Saudi Arabia is driven by a desire to reduce oil dependency, enhance economic stability amidst oil price fluctuations, and address environmental concerns by cutting carbon emissions, as highlighted by the Office of Energy Efficiency & Renewable Energy.

Why is Saudi Arabia a good country for solar energy?

Saudi Arabia is geographically suitable because it is located in the so-called sun belt, which has led it to become one of the largest solar energy producers. Solar energy is a serious competitor to conventional generation when the indirect costs of fossil fuels are included.

Does Saudi Arabia need a photovoltaic energy system?

Saudi Arabia is the largest country in the Middle East with huge solar energy resources but has achieved minimal adoption of photovoltaic energy systems (PV). This study investigates the potential of PV systems to address pressing challenges, including water scarcity and agricultural unemployment.

Which solar energy projects are completed in Saudi Arabia by 2030?

The Lunch of Saudi Solar Energy Program Sakaka, Al Shuaibah, and Sudair Solar Energy Projects have been completed. By 2030, the goal is 40GW PV solar and 2.7GW (CSP) concentrated solar power capacity.

Will Saudi Arabia install 50 GW of solar power by 2030?

The country aims to install 50 GW of solar capacity by 2030. Major projects include the 300-MW Sakaka solar plant, the 420-MW Sudair solar park, and the planned 2-GW Al-Shuaibah solar project. Saudi Arabia is also exploring innovative applications like floating solar farms on its reservoirs.

How much power does Saudi Arabia need?

Saudi Arabia has established a goal to source at least 50 percent of its power from renewable energy by 2030, expanding its capacity to 130 gigawatts (GW), 58.7 GW of which is expected to come from solar and 40 GW from wind. This target is the most ambitious of its kind among Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries (Figure 1).
