South Georgia, sometimes referred to as Isla San Pedro, is an island that is located in the South Atlantic Ocean and is part of the British administration of the South Sandwich Islands and part of the British Overseas Territory of South Georgia. The island is located 1400km from the Falkland Islands and is about 170km long and 35km wide.

The territory of South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands was formed in 1985. Argentina raised a territorial claim for South Georgia in 1927 and for the South Sandwich Islands in 1938. Argentina maintained a naval station, Corbeta Uruguay on Thule Island in the South Sandwich Islands from 1976 until 1982 when it was closed by the Royal Navy ...
