The price per watt for solar panels can range from \$2.50 to \$3.50, and largely depends on the home's geographical area. Residential solar panels are usually sized at 3kW to 8kW and can cost anywhere from \$9,255 and \$28,000 in total installation costs.

The weight of the system supported by the structure will be 156kg (i.e. 26kg $\times$ 6 PV panels).
