The key areas are structural safety of a building (Part A) and electrical safety of a building (Part P). 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What size solar panels do you need for your solar PV system? The number and size of your solar panels depend on the size of your property and energy demands. A 4kW solar system is one of the most popular sizes for domestic solar systems, as it is typically appropriate for homes with 3 to 4 people.

How much energy you could produce with solar panels - and therefore how much money you could make or save - will depend on: the size of your roof (the area you have available for panels); the pitch of your roof (the angle at which it tilts); the orientation of your roof (whether it faces north, south, east or west); the location of your home (which will affect how many hours ...

This has been calculated to give you the maximum exposure during all seasons i.e. the low sun in winter and the high sun in summer. The term "solar panel" is often used interchangeably to describe the panels that generate electricity and those that generate hot water. o Solar panels that produce electricity are known as solar photovoltaic (PV) modules. These panels generate electricity when exposed to light.

After the inverter has converted your solar panels' DC electricity into AC electricity, the AC cable will take it to your PV distribution board - that is, a fuse box for your solar panels. And in the vast majority of cases, this distribution board is connected to the supply meter - it won't need connecting to your existing consumer unit.

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
