

Solar power generation for sheep farming

Solar grazing suggests allowing livestock to retain access to the grasslands while the solar farm is in operation. This has benefits for both the solar farm and the livestock when compared to keeping them separate [5].

Incorporation of solar generation on dairy farms might be best suited to non-productive areas of the farm or on shed roofs, found the study. Adding solar panels to a 6-hectare sheep paddock on the case study farm could increase income for the farm by close to \$1 million, with net profit increasing over \$420,000

The O'Connors, a prominent farming family in Tasmania, are poised to undertake a groundbreaking project-- a vast 600-hectare solar farm, featuring 677,000 solar panels alongside 22,000 sheep in the paddocks.

The trend continues: on the NSW-ACT border, the 120MW Wallaroo Solar Farm plans to also operate as a 163-hectare sheep farm, with natives planted to attract bees; and plans for the 520MW Goulburn River Solar Farm in NSW include around 1000 sheep grazing beneath bifacial PV arrays standing five metres aboveground.
