

How will a new solar plant help Macedonia?

Andi Aranitasi, EBRD Head of North Macedonia, said: "The new solar plant will help the country, which faces severe air pollution from coal, to reduce its reliance on ageing coal-fired infrastructure. It will also generate cheap electricity in times of very high market prices.

Is Akuo Energy a strategic investment in North Macedonia?

Shortly after Akuo Energy's photovoltaic project of up to 400 MW in Stip was declared a strategic investment, the Government of North Macedonia gave the same status to two planned solar power plants in Pehcevo and Karbinci in the country's east. Renewable Power International will invest in a photovoltaic power plant with a capacity of 85 MW.

Is North Macedonia a good place to invest in green energy?

Dimitar Kovacevski, Prime Minister of North Macedonia: "It is really a great pleasure to be here today, where once a big environmental polluter was located and now we are producing green energy. The benefits of this investment are manifold.

How did Italy support the Oslomej 1 solar power plant?

In addition, Italy supported the project by financing the technical feasibility assessment. The Oslomej 1 solar power plant is one of the 21 flagship projects in the Western Balkan region, selected for the EU financing in 2022 through the WBIF.

What is the Oslomej 1 solar power plant?

The Oslomej 1 solar photovoltaic power plant is part of a larger effort to clean up the site, diversify energy sources and support decarbonisation. The EUR8.8 million investment is supported jointly by WBIF bilateral donors and the EU, in line with the 'Team Europe' approach.

Solar power plant investment North Macedonia

In Skopje, the President of the Management Board of the GEN-I Group, Dr Igor Koprivnikar, together with the Prime Minister of the Republic of North Macedonia, Dimitro Kovacevski, and the Minister of Economy, Kreshnik Bektesi, publicly presented the start of operation of the currently largest solar power plant in North Macedonia.

Furthermore, Bulgaria-based solar developer Solarpro Holding won, in April, a tender to build a 50 MW solar power plant at the former Oslomej coal power plant near Kicevo, North Macedonia.

In North Macedonia, one of the largest solar power plants in the region is being built on the site of a former coal mine in Oslomej - the project has been identified by the Western Balkans Investment Framework as one of 17 Flagship projects. Impact asset manager Finance in Motion arranged the financing, which is provided by the Green for Growth Fund.

EVN Macedonia Built the First Solar Photovoltaic (PV) Power Plant in North Macedonia with Bifacial Modules /15 th January 2021, by EVN Macedonia/. The first photovoltaic power plant in the country that simultaneously produces electricity from the sun and the reflection of light was installed in Negotino by EVN Macedonia at the end of 2020.

The 500 kW solar power plant is set to increase the firm's electricity output by about 700 MWh. Hidrosistem Strezevo CEO Metodije Gramatkovski said it is the first public company in North Macedonia that has built a photovoltaic power plant with its funds. It invested MKD 30,000,000 (about EUR 487,000) in the PV facility.

The investment is worth 40 million euros. The PV facility spans 57 hectares and consists of 101,000 panels. It includes over 856 kilometers of cables. Construction started in November. Mey Energy said its contractors are
