Mechanical noise can however be reduced to a large extent by applying sound absorbing materials and vibration suppression within the nacelle. This has resulted in aerodynamic noise becoming the primary noise source from wind turbines. Aerodynamic noise is flow-induced noise caused by interaction of the air passing over the turbine blades.
