Personal status matters of non-Muslims are based on civil law. The UAE constitution established a federal court system and allows all emirates to establish local courts systems.

Which emirate has its own court system?

Under the Constitution of the United Arab Emirates, each emirate is allowed to establish its own judiciary or to follow the federal court system. The UAE federal system includes courts of first instance (trial court), courts of appeal and the Supreme Court.

Is the United Arab Emirates a federation?

Where are gas and condensate found in Abu Dhabi?

In offshore fields of Abu Dhabi, such as the Hair Dalma, Satah, and Zakum fields, large volumes of gas and condensate are present in the Khuff Formation. Gas and condensates have also been discovered in the Lower-middle Cretaceous carbonates of the northern UAE, including Saleh, Sajaa, and Mubarek fields (Alsharhan, 1989).
