São Tomé; and Príncipe (STP) is making significant strides in advancing its climate-development agenda. The country has taken an inclusive and whole-of-society approach to its mitigation and adaptation actions and is working to integrate climate change into core planning and budgeting processes at national and subnational levels.

São Tomé and Príncipe has been working in collaboration with UNIDO, the World Bank, UNDP and other organisations to implement renewable energy projects in the country. The most advanced renewable energy project currently is the Santo Amaro solar photovoltaic power plant with 2.2 MWp, which is expected to be operational in early 2022.
