

# Taiwan context power

Which power plants will supply power in Taiwan?

The Hsinta Power Plant will supply power to companies in the Southeastern Taiwan Science Park, while the Datan Power Plant (????) will be responsible for users in Taoyuan and New Taipei City industrial parks, the company said. Those regional grids would also provide a pathway to switch to renewable energy, such as wind and solar power, Wang said.

How will Taiwan's energy storage system work?

At present, the largest energy storage system is a pumped storage power plant, but it can only store energy on a daily basis, not weekly, let alone monthly or seasonally. For Taiwan, this means that both gas and batteries will be required to keep the grid viable and running smoothly for industrial and residential customers alike.

Is Taiwan's electricity supply sufficient for industrial and household consumption?

While the government continues to stress that the electricity supply is sufficient for industrial and household consumption, Mark Liu, the Chairperson of TSMC with huge electricity demand, hinted at his shaken confidence in Taiwan's electricity supply when he expressed an ambiguous comment in June 2023.

How many substations does Taipower have?

In terms of transmission and distribution, Taipower's system has 622 substations, and its total length of power transmission lines reached 18,230.3 circuit kilometers while its total length of distribution lines reached 422,640 circuit kilometers in 2023.
