



Tesla connects to photovoltaic panels

In your situation, I would connect the excess PV greater than about 5 kW to the main panel as you suggest, and try to have the PV that is part of the backup system be the best exposure panels you have, probably south. This excess PV greater than 5 kW would also not have any gateway CT's on it so the Tesla system would be blind to it.

The Powerwall, most likely, will not be backfed into your panel. They will install the gateway, and the



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gateway will be connected to the supply side of your main panel. With a 200 amp panel, you are likely limited to your 40 amps. To add another solar system, you would either add it outside (connected to the Powerwall gateway, and not backed up).
