Who owns the power plant in the Gambia?

These facilities are operated by National Water and Electricity Company (NAWEC) and Karadeniz Power ship Koray Bey Company Limited - an Independent Power Producer (IPP). In 2018, the effective electric installed capacity in The Gambia was around 135 MW.

Is the Gambia facing a serious energy crisis?

Notable projects include an interconnection with Senegal, which provides 50MW of power to augment The Gambia's bulk supply system. The progress report, however, points out that The Gambia is confronted with a severe energy (especially electricity) crisis that hampers growth and private sector development.
