

How will Tonga move away from fossil fuels?

This project aims to help Tonga move away from fossil fuels and shift to renewables. The project will deliver utility-scale storage systems to provide base load response and grid stability, paving the way for more renewable energy integration in the main island, while green mini-grids will be installed in the outer islands.

What is the Tonga solar project?

1. The project will construct and install solar power systems with a total capacity of 1.32 MWp on the outer islands of Tonga, and the existing grid network on the islands of Vava'u and 'Eua rehabilitated by TPL. (The rehabilitated grid network portions on Vava'u and 'Eua are expanded). 2.

How can Tonga transform its energy sector?

The Government of Tonga has formulated targets to transform its energy sector by achieving a 50 percent share of renewables in the country's energy generation mix by 2020 and 70 percent by 2030. However, achieving these targets require catalytic investments to transform the country's energy infrastructure.

How many MWp of power will be built in Tonga?

1. THE PROJECT WILL CONSTRUCT AND INSTALL POWER SYSTEMS WITH A TOTAL CAPACITY OF 1.32 MWp ON THE OUTER ISLANDS OF TONGA, AND THE EXISTING GRID NETWORK ON THE ISLANDS OF VAVAU AND EUA REHABILITATED BY TPL (THE REHABILITATED GRID NETWORK PORTIONS ON VAVAU AND EUA ARE EXPANDED). (Phase 1): The plants have been built and are operational.
