What is solar photovoltaic (PV) power generation?

Solar photovoltaic (PV) power generation is the process of converting energy from the sun into electricity using solar panels. Solar panels, also called PV panels, are combined into arrays in a PV system. PV systems can also be installed in grid-connected or off-grid (stand-alone) configurations.

A PV system generate electricity by converting solar energy directly into electricity using PV cells (solar panels/modules), which are the system's most important components (Gorjian and Shukla, 2020).
